**About the Class:** The Domestic Terrorism course, sponsored by NTAC and the Pahrump Justice Court provides the necessary enabling tools to proactively develop, collect, retrieve, and disseminate information and intelligence pertaining to terrorism and multi-jurisdictional crime. In addition the information derived from the training will assist in the future identification of domestic extremists engaged in criminal or terrorist activities as illustrated by the following outline/objectives:

1. Understand the definition and scope of United States Domestic Terrorism.
2. Understand anti-government Ideology.
3. Understand the two-tiered Sovereign Citizens Movement track and its foundational ideology.
4. Recognize and identify Sovereign Citizen Tactics often used during traffic & enforcement stops.
5. Examine procedures employed by public employees when interacting with Sovereigns.
6. Recognize the challenges of enforcing/ interacting with anti-government protestors at Bundy type events.
7. Understand Patriot Movements, including militias and tax protestor groups/ideology.
8. Understand 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment Auditors' modus operandi, their tactics and legal standing.
