

## **NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA) CDBG-CV ROUND #2**

In response to the Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) notified the Nevada Non-Entitlement CDBG Program that it received a formula allocation in the amount of \$9,963,639 from the second round of CDBG-CV funding to be used specifically for the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the Coronavirus. The allocation was authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, which was signed on March 27, 2020. This allocation is to be distributed across the state of Nevada to entitlement and non-entitlement areas, based on a HUD formula specific to Allocation #2.

The designated Entitlement and Non-Entitlement cities and counties will submit projects to the State of Nevada – CDBG-CV Program. Cities, counties and non-profit organizations can submit projects to the designated jurisdictions. Refer to table for allocations by jurisdictions. Applications are due to the State of Nevada by April 27, 2021 by 5:00 p.m.

The Method of Distribution (MoD) follows the 2020 CDBG guidelines, with flexibilities provided for the initial CDBG-CV #1 funds. They are:

- (1) An expedited application and review process;
- (2) A shortened public comment period;
- (3) Lifting of the 15% cap on public services.

CDBG-CV Round #2 will observe the normal noticing and public comment period. Two Public Meetings are required. A minimum of two weeks is required between properly noticed Public Meetings.

Please refer to the CDBG website listed below and the 2019 Annual Action Plan Amendment for CDBG-CV, as well as ESG-CV and HOPWA-CV amendments. The Citizens' Participation Plan was revised to reflect the 5-day Public Comment Period, if needed.

The CDBG-CV #2 application process opens November 11, 2020; applications will be accepted until April 27, 2021 by 5:00 p.m. PDT. Refer to the Quick Guide for CDBG Eligible Activities posted on the link above. The CDBG-CV Guidebook for Round #2 and the application process is through ZoomGrants. Cities and Counties may submit two applications and sponsor two applications from non-profit organizations. A CDBG-CV Virtual Training will be held Thursday, November 19, 2020: 9:00 to 11:00 A.M. PST and 1:00 to 3:00 P.M. PST. Details will follow.
